Sub: - Issuance of No Objection Certificate/ Essentiality Certificate to establish new Medical College with 100 seats in the name of ESIC Medical at NH 3, NIT Faridabad by Employees State Insurance Corporation, Ministry of Labour and Employment, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

Reference No. DGMER/2013/3695, dated 19.9.2013 on the subject noted above.

2. The Essentiality Certificate is as under:-

1.	No. of Institution already existing in the State	07 Medical College
2.	No. of seats available or No. of Doctors being produced annually.	Till date, 700 Doctors are being produced annually. From this academic session, SHKM Govt. Medical College, Nalhar (Mewat) will admit the first batch of 100 students and consequently 100 more Doctors will be produced annually only after four years.
3.	No. Doctors registered with the State Medical Council.	7428
4.	No. of Doctors in Govt. Service	2036
5.	No. Govt. Post vacant and those in rural/difficult area	About 499

7.	Doctors and population ratio in the State	1:5179
8.	How the establishment of the College would resolve problem of deficiencies of qualified medical personals in the State and improve the availability of such medical manpower in the State.	Presently there are only seven Medical Colleges in the State which has a population of over two crore. An establishment of a Medical College will enhance the numbers of qualified doctors and thereby doctor-patient ratio will improve.
9.	The restriction imposed by the State Govt. if any on students who are not domiciled in the State from obtaining admissions in the State, be specified	The admissions of this college would be as per the guidelines of the State Government/MCI/Central Govt.
10.	Full justification for opening of the proposed college	The WHO has recommended a ratio of one doctor for every 1000 population. Haryana has just one doctor per 5179 people. The average is 1:1441 at National level. Existing Medical Colleges in Haryana cannot meet this requirement. The opening of Medical College will help to rectify this deficiency.
11.	Doctors-Patient ratio proposal to be advised	1 : 1000

Dr. Asim Das, Dean, ESIC Medical College, Faridabad, on behalf of Employees State Insurance Corporation, New Delhi has applied for establishment of ESIC Medical College at NH-3-NIT Faridabad. On careful consideration of the proposal, the Govt. of Haryana has decided to issue an Essentiality Certificate for the Establishment of Medical College with 100 seats. It is certified that:-

- a. The applicant owns and manages a 300 bedded hospital which is operational.
- b. It is desirable to establish a Medical College in the public interest.
- c. Establishment of the ESIC Medical College at Faridabad is feasible.
- d. Adequate clinical material as per the Medical Council of India norms is available.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the medical college as per MCI norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Govt. the State Govt. shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the college with the permission of the Central Government.

The Essentiality Certificate is further subject to the following conditions:-

1. The ESIC will provide all infrastructure/staff/facilities for training of students required as per MCI norms.
2. The ESIC will not admit any student without obtaining prior permission of Central Govt. (Ministry of Health & Family Welfare)/MCI/Affiliating University.
3. The ESIC will abide by all terms/conditions/regulations imposed by Central Govt. (Ministry of Health & Family Welfare)/ State Govt./MCI/Affiliating University issued from time to time.
4. The ESIC will also submit a Bank Guarantee of Rs. 2.00 Crore in favour of State Government before starting the course.
